**Board of Directors Meeting (Highlights)
January 19, 2010**

- Current membership: 75 Active Members (8 of these are 85-yr. enactment members) + 12 Honorary Members
- 2009/2010 Goal: 73
- December Attendance 69.81%
- Financials through 12/31/09 distributed. Nothing unusual reported. We are running very close to budget.
- **Internal Audit** – Wes Jones submitted his report on the Club and Charitable Fund for the year ending 6/30/09 to Tom Hicken. Wes found nothing unusual to report.
- **Super Bowl Raffle:** Final numbers not yet reported, however, there were no winners from our club.
- **Creative Fining:** Final total reported at \$3,970.00
- **Entertainment Books:** Al bought the last 3 books. Board members encouraged to be on the lookout for buyers.
- **Member Recruitment Development:** Red badge members are moving forward. Tom Tegeder is working on an application for Mary Charapata. Tammy Krukowski (Chiropractor) attended Monday's meeting and picked up an application. The club has also received a few inquiries via the website.
- **Rotary Foundation** – The board continued their discussion about helping current members, who are at the \$700 level or higher, obtain their Paul Harris Fellowship.
- **World Affairs Seminar** – Jeff will talk with the Interact students at Waukesha West to see if there is an interest on the part of anyone to participate in the 2010 event to be held at Carroll University.
- **Interact:** Jeff reported on the many activities the West group is involved in: Polar Plunge, Helping with raffle sales at our Pancake Festival, obtaining a \$2,500 grant. They have started selling tickets to our Pancake Festival as well. Alcy will give a short talk at our February business meeting.
- **Community Service Projects:** Michelle DuBord is working on a club survey which will be distributed to club members for suggestions.
- **Public Relations:** Press releases and Public Service Announcements for the Pancake Festival have been written and approved by Shelly. Releases have been sent to all area magazines. As deadlines approach, releases will be sent to newspapers, radio and TV stations.
- Resignations of Kathy Madden and Patrick Schmitt accepted.
- **Cell Phones For Soldiers:** It was agreed that the club could do a 3-week long collection for this project. More information to follow.
- **Scholarships:** Jeff will give a short presentation asking club members to let him know of any scholarships (Rotary, Business, Misc. Organizations) that the students in our Interact Club at West could apply for. Colleen will send a club e-mail out with the same request.
- **Speaker Equipment:** pull down screen, wireless microphone, power point projector were briefly discussed. These items will be placed on the February agenda.
- **Next Meeting:** February 16, 2010 – 7:15 a.m. – Jannsen & Co.
